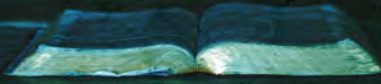

## SPECIAL CHRISTMAS OFFERING

The Dominican Republic has been experiencing a revival that is reaching into all of Latin America. This December, we are taking a special Christmas offering for the Los Toros Church Plant and Training Center. This church was planted by three pastors: Eugenio, Mariano, and Wander. These three grew up together in the southern, poorest part of the Dominican Republic. The only churches around them were plagued with bad theology. Because of the need for a biblically sound church, they were counselled to plant one.

The goal is for this to be a healthy church, ministering to the surrounding community, but also to be the first training center for those pastors in the south who cannot go to get theological training in the capital. When it is established, we can send our missions teams there to train leaders and lead VBS camps. Last year we gave toward this project which provided the window and door bars. This year we would love to raise the funds needed for the gate and, Lord willing, the completion of the church. Let's pray and plan to give generously for the sake of the spread of the unadulterated Gospel through this church . There will be a special offering for this ministry
