THE WORD IN YOU: AUGUST MEMORY VERSE

Psalm 27:14 As believers in Christ we are called to wait for the Lord. The particular word for waiting used in this verse connotes a sense of eager and patient anticipation of the Lord. The psalmist concludes here on a triumphant note that despite his difficulties, he is strongly convinced that the Lord will come to his rescue. In that light, he encourages the people to likewise wait for the Lord. God is our portion and strength, and he sustains his people by his spirit. We are to wait on the Lord by faith, and prayer, and a humble resignation to his will. Likewise, we are to be of good courage; letting our hearts be fixed on God, trusting in him, and having our minds stayed upon him.
